WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, John W. Jordan
and Tennessee J. Jordan his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Twenty Eight Hundred DOLLARS,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said M. V. Adams and George W. Adams
and unto their heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Cherokee Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The West $(\frac{1}{2})$ half of the South West $(\frac{1}{4})$ quarter of the North West $(\frac{1}{4})$ quarter of Section (36)
Thirty Six Township (20) Twenty North Range (12) Twelve East containing 2.0 acres more
or less, according to United States survey thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said M. V. Adams + George W. Adams
and unto their heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said M. V. Adams and George W. Adams that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Tennessee J. Jordan wife of the said John W. Jordan for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said M. V. Adams
George W. Adams all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
