WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Charles McKee
and Mary J. McKee (formerly Mary J. Burnett) his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Fifteen Hundred DOLLARS,
Cash in hand paid to us by Charles McKee and wife Mary J. McKee, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said G. S. Kemble and Rosa Kemble
and unto their heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: Beginning at the North West Corner of Lot Five (5) in Section Six (6) in
Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Thirteen (13) East and run thence due East One Hundred and Fifty (150) Feet; thence
due South Three Hundred (300) Feet; thence due West One Hundred and Fifty (150) Feet; and then due North Three Hundred
(300) Feet to the Point of Beginning, the same being a strip of ground extending One Hundred and Fifty (150) Feet East
and West and Three Hundred Feet (300) North and South and adjoining and lying just West of the land sold and
conveyed to the above named grantees by Warranty deed executed by Mary J. Burnett, on the 5th day
of March, 1906.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said G. S. Kemble and Rosa Kemble
and unto their heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
And we hereby covenant with said G. S. Kemble and Rosa Kemble that we will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, wife of the said for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
