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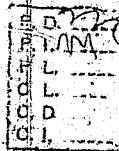

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Ida B. Northrup, formerly, Ida B. Sherman, and
and Wesley Northrup her husband his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Five hundred DOLLARS,
In hand paid by W. O. Dickenson, receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said W. O. Dickenson
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Cherokee Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot four (4) of Section six (6) containing 37.06 acres and north one half of south west
quarter of north west quarter, of section six (6) Township twenty two (22) North Range thirteen
(13) East.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said W. O. Dickenson
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
And hereby covenant with said W. O. Dickenson that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Wesley Northrup, husband wife of the said Ida B. Northrup, formerly Ida B. Northrup for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
W. O. Dickenson all my rights of ^{County} dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
