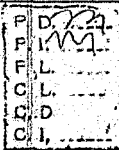

OFFICIAL FORM

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, John O Mitchell
and Alice M. Mitchell his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Sixty (\$60.00) DOLLARS,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the grantor

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Enos L. Larkin, Tulsa, Indian Territory,
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot four (4), Block eleven (11), West Tulsa, Creek Nation, Indian Territory,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Enos L. Larkin
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
And hereby covenant with said Enos L. Larkin that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Alice M. Mitchell wife of the said John O. Mitchell for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
Enos L. Larkin all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
