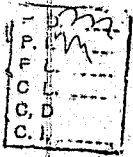

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, I, Donn Piatt, (a single man)
 and _____ his wife, for and in consideration
 of the sum of One and 00/100 DOLLARS,
Cash in hand paid by Eugene A. Smith, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Eugene A. Smith
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
 District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot No. One (1) in Block No. Sixteen (16) in the Lynch & Faraythe Addition
to the town of Tulsa, according to the official Plat and survey thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Eugene A. Smith
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Eugene A. Smith that I will forever
 warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, _____ wife of the said _____ for and
 in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said _____
 all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
