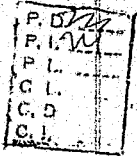

OFFICIAL FORM

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Alex S. Lewis
and Elizabeth P. Lewis his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of One Thousand DOLLARS,
In hand paid by Henry C. Walckley, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Henry C. Walckley
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Cheyenne Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The lower interest of Nancy J. Lebrun (formerly Nancy J. Leage) and an undivided one third interest in and
to the South one half of North West quarter of Section Twenty four (24) Township Twenty (20) North Range Thirteen
(13) East.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Henry C. Walckley
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenants with said Henry C. Walckley that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Elizabeth P. Lewis wife of the said Alex S. Lewis for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
Henry C. Walckley all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
