do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Loren Conaway
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots nineteen & Twenty (19 & 20) Block Twelve (12), Lots nineteen & Twenty
(19 & 20) Block Thirteen (13), Lots one & two (1 & 2) Block Fourteen (14), Lots Twenty-one
& Twenty-two (21 & 22) Block Fourteen, Lynch & Forsythes Addition to Jucsa, Ind. Ter.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Loren Conaway
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

in the acceptance of this deed that there is to be no drilling for oil or gas on above lots.

in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said

Loren Conaway all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
