Know all Men by these Presents, That we, I Eli Grason, a Creek Indian, Twenty one
and years age and a single man his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Seven hundred and forty seven DOLLARS,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said J. W. Mann
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot no. three (3) in section nineteen (19) Township nineteen (19) north,
Range fourteen (14) East, containing thirty seven and 3/100 acres more or
less according to the Government survey

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said J. W. Mann
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenants with said J. W. Mann that I will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, wife of the said for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
