Know all Men by these Presents, That we, J. Ed. Barksdale, a single man

hereby paid to Ed Barksdale, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Charles Haley
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot ten (10) in Block five (5) in the Bellview Addition to the Town of
Julesa, Indian Territory

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Charles Haley
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
And hereby covenant with said Charles Haley that I will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, my wife of the said for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
