

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Frederick G. Stevens
and Margaret M. Stevens his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Eleven hundred (\$1100.00) DOLLARS,
cash in hand paid

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Ethel E. Gillies
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The South Twelve and one half feet (12-1/2) of lot no. (5) Five and the
North Twenty five feet (25) of lot Four (4) in Block One hundred and thirty eight
(138) Tulsa, Indian Territory

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Ethel E. Gillies
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Ethel E. Gillies that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Margaret M. Stevens wife of the said Frederick G. Stevens for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said

Ethel E. Gillies all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
