Know all Men by these Presents, That we, John A. Oliphant
 and Martha G. Oliphant his wife, for and in consideration
 of the sum of Three Hundred DOLLARS,
 in hand paid by Charles W. Grimes the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Charles W. Grimes
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
 District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots 21 and 22 in Block No 2, in the Bellview Addition to Tulsa

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Charles W. Grimes
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
 And hereby covenant with said Charles W. Grimes that he will forever
 warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Martha G. Oliphant wife of the said John A. Oliphant for and
 in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
Charles W. Grimes all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
