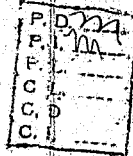

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, C. B. Lynch
and E. J. Lynch his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of four hundred (\$400.00) DOLLARS,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged in full.

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Frank Miller
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot Fourteen (14) Block Eleven (11) Lynch & Forsyth's Addition to Tulsa, I. T.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Frank Miller
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenants with said Frank Miller that their will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, E. J. Lynch wife of the said C. B. Lynch for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
Frank Miller all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
