Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Frances Smith
and a single and unmarried woman his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Two Hundred and Seventy DOLLARS,
in hand paid by Alfred M. Krug, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Alfred M. Krug
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the west line of Section 7,
73 1/2 feet north of the Southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of said section, thence north
97 1/2 feet; thence east 125 feet; thence south 97 1/2 feet; thence west 125 feet to the
place of beginning and all being in Section (7) Township (18) and Range (13) East

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Alfred M. Krug
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenants with said Alfred M. Krug that she will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, wife of the said for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
