do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said J. M. Wooden  
and unto His heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Levee Nation Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot "Seven" Block Nine (9) Lindsey's Second addition to the town of Tulsa, Ind. Terr.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said J. M. Wooden  
and unto His heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. M. Wooden that they will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, L. W. Lindsey husband wife of the said Lila W. Lindsey for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said  
J. M. Wooden all my rights of coverture and homestead in and to the said lands.
