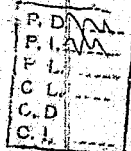

## WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, C. C. Sigler and L. Inez Sigler, his wife  
and David L. Sleeper, her sole partner as D. L. Sleeper and Della B. Sleeper his wife, for and in consideration  
of the sum of Two Thousand no. v. v. DOLLARS,  
to them in hand paid by William J. Clark the receipt whereof is acknowledged

do, hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said William J. Clark  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The undivided one fourth interest in and to the northwest quarter of Section Nineteen  
(17) Township Nineteen (18) N. Range Thirteen (13) E. being the Adeline Bruner interest in said  
Quarter, same being all our interest in said land

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said William J. Clark  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.  
C. C. Sigler and David L. Sleeper  
And, hereby covenant with said William J. Clark that they will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, L. Inez Sigler and Della B. Sleeper, wife of the said David L. Sleeper for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said  
William J. Clark all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
