Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Thomas Wiswall
and Aileen Wiswall his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Six Hundred DOLLARS,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Jessie L. Hollis
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Levee Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

beginning at a point 721 feet South of the Quarter Section corner between sections Eleven (11) and Twelve (12), Township
Nineteen (19) North Range Twelve (12) East and running thence on a magnetic course South 74 Degrees West 444 feet to the
left bank of the Arkansas River, thence down said bank to its intersection with the section line between sections 11
and 12 Township 19 N. R. 12 E. thence north along said section line to place of beginning, being three (3) acres more
or less out of S.W. corner of lot 2 section 11, Township 19 N. R. 12 E.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Jessie L. Hollis
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Jessie L. Hollis that I will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all ~~persons and claims what-so-ever, except such a certain oil lease~~
~~hitherto made in favor of George Barnes Jr.~~

And I, Aileen Wiswall wife of the said Thomas Wiswall for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
Jessie L. Hollis all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
