confessed

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Ethel E. Gillies
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

All of Lot Five (5) in Block One Hundred and Forty Six (146) in the City of
Tulsa, Indian Territory, according to the recorded plat thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Ethel E. Gillies
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Ethel E. Gillies that we will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Miriam Timbers wife of the said W. E. Timbers

And I, Anna J. Amison wife of the said William Amison for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said

Ethel E. Gillies all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
