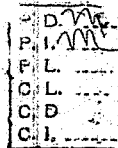

OFFICIAL FORM

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Lela D. Lindsey
and L. W. Lindsey, her husband his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Three Hundred Fifty (\$350.00) DOLLARS,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Meldon J. Baker and Ella Baker, his wife
and unto their heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot number Nine (9), in Block number Ten (10), in Lindsay second Add Addition to the
city of Tulsa, as shown by the plat thereof made by J. Gus Patten

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Meldon J. Baker and Ella Baker
and unto their heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Meldon J. Baker and Ella Baker that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, L. W. Lindsey husband wife of the said Lela D. Lindsey for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Meldon J. Baker
and Ella Baker all my rights of ^{courtesy} dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
