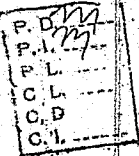

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Jay Forsythe
and Jennie Forsythe his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Twelve hundred (\$1200⁰⁰) DOLLARS,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged in full

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said J.E. and J.L. Smiley
and unto their heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots Sixteen, seventeen & eighteen (16-17 & 18) Block Ten (10)
Lynch & Forsythe's Addition to Tulsa, Ind. Ter.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said J.E. & J.L. Smiley
and unto their heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
And hereby covenant^s with said J.E. & J.L. Smiley that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Jennie Forsythe wife of the said Jay Forsythe for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
J.E. & J.L. Smiley all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
