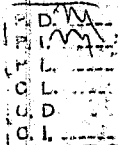

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said International Land Company, its successors
 and unto heirs and assigns, forever, the following land lying and being in the of and Nation
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The northeast quarter of the south east quarter of Section twelve (12) Township nineteen (19) north Range fourteen (14) East, being the allotment
of Hester Runnel.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said International Land Company, its successors
 and unto heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
Lemona Daniels And hereby covenant with said International Land Company that said lands are free from all in and to that I will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, wife of the said for and
 in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
