Know all Men by these Presents, That we, I John Tiger, a widower
and we of Muskogee (Creek) Nation, Indian Territory, his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of One dollar and other good and valuable considerations DOLLARS,
same paid by International Land Company, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said International Land Company, its successors,
and unto heirs and assigns, forever, the following described lot of land of ground lying and being situated in the Creek Nation,
District, of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The South east quarter of section sixteen (16) Township seventeen (17) North Range thirteen (13) east of the Indian Base and Meridian
of the Indian Territory and according to the Government Survey thereof, same being the allotment of Miller Tiger my deceased wife who died on the
24th day of September 1906.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said International Land Company
and unto heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
And, hereby covenant with the said International Land Company that said lands are free from all incumbrances that I will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, wife of the said for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
