Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Elenor Arnold
and E. M. Arnold, her husband his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of One thousand DOLLARS,
cash in hand paid by R. B. Archibald, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged.

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said R. B. Archibald
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

lots 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, and 16 in block 14 in the Town Addition to the town of Broken Arrow, D.T., according to the
recorded plat thereof filed at Wagoner, D.T.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said R. B. Archibald
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
And hereby covenant with said R. B. Archibald that we will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Elenor Arnold wife of the said E. M. Arnold for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
R. B. Archibald all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
