## WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Henry C. Walkley a single man,  
and Emma C. Mass his wife, for and in consideration  
of the sum of Seven Hundred DOLLARS,  
in hand paid by I. H. Mass the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Emma C. Mass  
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Cherokee Nation Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

South one half of North West quarter of Section twenty four (24) Township twenty (20) North Range  
thirteen (13) East, containing Eighty acres.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Emma C. Mass  
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenants with said Emma C. Mass that I will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I wife of the said Emma C. Mass for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said  
Emma C. Mass all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
