Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Mrs. Sallie W. Gilcrest
and W. W. Gilcrest her husband of Broken Arrow, in Creek Nation, Indian Territory, his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Seventy-five Dollars DOLLARS,
to my said boy J. J. Holt, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said J. J. Holt
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following described lot of ground lying and being situated in the town of Broken Arrow, Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot Number Four (4) and Five (5) in Block Number Twenty-one (21) in said town of Broken Arrow, Indian
Territory.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said J. J. Holt
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereto belonging.

And hereby covenants with said J. J. Holt that said lands are free from incumbrances that we will forever
warrant and defend the title to said lands against all lawful claims whatever.

And I, Mrs. Sallie W. Gilcrest wife of the said W. W. Gilcrest for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. J. Holt
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
