parties of the second part, dowered real property and premises, situated in County
and unto heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: assignee forever the following lands lying in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of
the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the West half (sharon on the U.S. survey as lots one (1) and two (2) of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section
thirty-one (31) Township nineteen (19) north of Range fourteen (14) east, Creek Nation, Western District
of the Indian Territory town lot No. two (2) in block fourteen (4), lot No. seventeen (17) in in
blocks seven (7) and an undivided half interest in lot No nine (9) in block ten (10) all
of the above western section of land, together with all improvements thereon and the appurtenances
thereto belonging, and warrant the title to the same.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said described premises unto the said party of the second
and unto part, her, heirs and assigns, forever, free clear and discharged of and from all farms of lands, charges,
