Know all Men by these Presents, That we, D. A. Rupe  
and Jesse M. Rupe his wife, for and in consideration  
of the sum of Six hundred and no/100 DOLLARS,  
to him paid cash in hand, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged  
this day received from G. M. Ellison

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said G. M. Ellison  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Cherokee Nation Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots seventeen (17) eighteen (18) and nineteen (19) in block number  
twenty five (25), sec within the town of Skiatook, Indian Territory and  
within the western Judicial District, said Territory

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said G. M. Ellison  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.  
And hereby covenants with said G. M. Ellison that they will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Jesse M. Rupe wife of the said D. A. Rupe for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said  
G. M. Ellison all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
