Know all Men by these Presents, That we, S. W. Marr
and Anna M. Marr his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of One hundred fifty (150.00) DOLLARS,
in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Arthur C. Meier
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot 9, in Block 5, in the Bellview Addition to the town of
Julesa, Indian Territory

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Arthur C. Meier
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Arthur C. Meier that we will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Anna M. Marr wife of the said S. W. Marr for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
Arthur C. Meier all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
