accepted and acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Lewis E. Berry  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot Five (5) in Block One (1) in Harbour's addition to the  
Town of Tulsa, I. T. according to the dedicated and certified plat thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Louis E. Berry  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Louis E. Berry that they will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, F. J. Harbour wife of the said J. J. Harbour for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said  
Louis E. Berry all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
