Know all Men by these Presents, That we, William M. Jewel
and Lelia J. Jewel his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Eleven Hundred (\$1100) DOLLARS,
to us in hand paid receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, by M. E. Haigh

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said M. E. Haigh
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the town of Junes Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

All of Lot seven (7), Block One hundred seventy-four (174), in the aforesaid town,
according to the government plat of the aforesaid town

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said M. E. Haigh
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
And hereby covenant with said M. E. Haigh that we will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Lelia J. Jewel wife of the said William M. Jewel for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
M. E. Haigh all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
