

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, W. L. Britton
and Susie L. Britton his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of One Thousand no/1000 DOLLARS,
The receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged and to us in hand paid

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said R. C. Strickland
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

South Fifty Feet Lot Two (2) Block Three (3) in the "Burnette Addition"
to the City of Tulsa, Ind Ter. and according to the Plat & Survey thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said R. C. Strickland
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
And hereby covenant with said R. C. Strickland that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Susie L. Britton wife of the said W. L. Britton for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
R. C. Strickland all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
