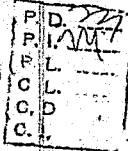

## WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Arch Hayes  
and Hester A. Hayes his wife, for and in consideration  
of the sum of Forty five Hundred DOLLARS,  
In hand paid by E. J. Arnett, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said E. J. Arnett  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The West half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the South west quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the North East fourth ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the  
South West quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) All of Section Sixteen (16) Township Nineteen (19) North of Range  
thirteen (13) East of J.M. Containing 120 acres less M. R. and O. right of way

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said E. J. Arnett  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.  
And hereby covenant with said E. J. Arnett that they will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Hester A. Hayes wife of the said Arch Hayes for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said  
E. J. Arnett all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
