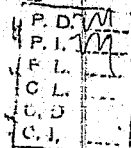

## WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, John Fields  
and Anna Fields his wife, for and in consideration  
of the sum of one DOLLARS,  
and other valuable considerations the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said George W. Adams  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 Sec. 23 Tp. 19 R. 13 East

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said George W. Adams  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.  
And hereby covenant with said George W. Adams that they will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Anna Fields wife of the said John Fields for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said  
George W. Adams all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
