Know all Men by these Presents, That we, John A. Oliphant
and Martha G. Oliphant his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of One Hundred Eighty Seven & 5/100 DOLLARS,
in hand paid by Oral Stacy Aldrich, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Oral Stacy Aldrich
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot 20 and the north half of Lot 19, in Block 2, in Bellevue Addition to Tulsa, D.T.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Oral Stacy Aldrich
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Oral Stacy Aldrich that I will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Martha G. Oliphant wife of the said John A. Oliphant for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
Oral Stacy Aldrich all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
