Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Thomas E. Shaw
and Gracia D. Shaw his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Twenty Five Hundred (2500.00) DOLLARS,
In hand paid by James A. McClure, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged.

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said James A. McClure
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Twenty eighth (28) ^{recording district} ~~Western~~
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: Beginning at a point four hundred and eighty four (484) feet South of the
Quarter Section Corner, between Sections Eleven (11) and Twelve (12) Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Twelve (12)
East, and running thence West seven hundred and twenty two (722) feet to the left bank of the Arkansas River; thence
Southeasterly, along said bank, two hundred and sixty two (262) feet, thence East five hundred and sixty (560) feet, to
the section line between Sections Eleven (11) and Twelve (12) of said Township and Range; thence North along said section line
two hundred and six (206) feet to the place of beginning, containing Three and Two Hundredths (3.02) acres more or
less, being a part of lot seven (7) in Section Eleven (11) Township Nineteen (19) North Range Twelve (12) East

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said James A. McClure
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said James A. McClure that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Gracia D. Shaw wife of the said Thomas E. Shaw for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
James A. McClure all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
