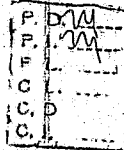

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Mary D. Kreager
and Henry A. Kreager her husband his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Two hundred fifty DOLLARS,
In hand paid by Ella Britton the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Ella Britton
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot twenty (26) in Block two (2) in the Oklahoma Addition to the town
of Tulsa, I. T.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Ella Britton
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Ella Britton that she will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Henry A. Kreager, husband wife of the said Mary D. Kreager for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
Ella Britton all my rights of ^{courtesy} dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
