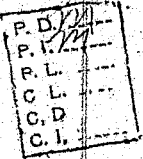

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, H. R. Cline
and Etta Fair Cline his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) DOLLARS,
receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said City of Tulsa, Indian Territory
and unto its ^{successors} heirs and assigns, forever; the following lands lying in the Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The South one-half (1/2) of Lot Five (5), Block Twelve (12) in the platted
Addition to the City of Tulsa known as North Tulsa Addition as the same appears
on file in the United States District Clerk's Office at Vinita, Indian Territory

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said City of Tulsa, I.T.
and unto its ^{successors} heirs and assigns; forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
And hereby covenant with said City of Tulsa, I.T. that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Etta Fair Cline wife of the said H. R. Cline for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
City of Tulsa, I.T. all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
