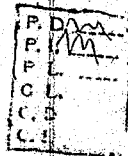

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, J. J. Harbour
and J. J. Harbour his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Three Hundred (\$300.00) DOLLARS,
Cash in hand paid to them by A. J. Farren the receipt of which is hereby accepted
and acknowledged.

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said A. J. Farren
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot Three (3) in Block One (1) in Harbour's Addition to the Town of Tulsa
I. J. according to the certified and dedicated plat thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said A. J. Farren
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said A. J. Farren that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, J. J. Harbour wife of the said J. J. Harbour for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
A. J. Farren all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
