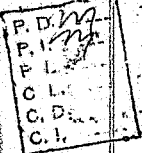

OFFICIAL FORM

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, W. D. Weaver
and Bettie Weaver his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Twenty-three hundred and no/100 DOLLARS,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Thomas Wiswall
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa, Creek Nation, Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

All of the South Half (1/2) of Lot Numbered Three (3) in Block Numbered One
Hundred One (101), situate in the City of Tulsa, Creek Nation, Indian Territory,
according to the official plat thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Thomas Wiswall
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Thomas Wiswall that we will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Bettie Weaver wife of the said W. D. Weaver for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
Thomas Wiswall all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
