WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, S. J. Jack
and Mollie E. Jack his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Eight Hundred fifty and 00/100 DOLLARS,
to use in hand paid by C. H. Overton and J. J. Taylor, the receipt of which is
hereby acknowledged.

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said C. H. Overton and J. J. Taylor
and unto their heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot Two (2) in Block Thirty Seven (37) in the City of Tulsa, Indian
Territory, according to the government survey of said City:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said C. H. Overton and J. J. Taylor
and unto their heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said C. H. Overton and J. J. Taylor that we will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Mollie E. Jack wife of the said S. J. Jack for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
C. H. Overton and J. J. Taylor all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
