Know all Men by these Presents, That we, William M. Jewel and Lelia J. Jewel
and his wife, for and in consideration
 of the sum of Two thousand eight hundred DOLLARS,
 (\$2800) to us in hand paid by Percy Collins, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged.

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Percy Collins
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Town of Tulsa Western
 District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of Lot four (4) and the South fifty (50) feet of Lot five (5), Block one hundred eighty
three (183), according to the government plat of the aforesaid town; being a plat of ground
one hundred and fifty (150) feet by one hundred and forty (140) feet, having a frontage
of one hundred fifty (150) feet on Cincinnati Street, and a frontage of one hundred and
forty (140) feet on Ninth Street

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Percy Collins
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Percy Collins that we will forever
 warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Lelia J. Jewel wife of the said William M. Jewel for and
 in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said

Percy Collins all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
