Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Emma Drew  
and C. C. Drew her husband his wife, for and in consideration  
of the sum of Nine Hundred (\$900.00) DOLLARS,  
Cash in hand paid by Lon R. Stansbery, the receipt of which is hereby  
acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Lon R. Stansbery  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Drew's Add. to Tulsa Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The South One Hundred (100) feet of Lot Four (4) in Block One (1) in  
Drew's Addition to the City of Tulsa, I. T. more particularly described as follows: Beginning  
at the Southeast corner of said Lot 4 in Block 1; thence North 100 feet; thence west  
135 feet; thence South 100 feet; thence East 135 feet to the place of beginning  
all in Lot 4, Block 1, Drew's Add. to Tulsa, I. T.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Lon R. Stansbery  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant & with said Lon R. Stansbery that we will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, C. C. Drew husband wife of the said Emma Drew for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said  
Lon R. Stansbery all my rights of <sup>Certain</sup> ~~dower~~ and homestead in and to the said lands.
