

OFFICIAL FORM

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Luella Thacker (formerly Luella Williamson)
and H. A. Thacker, her husband his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Five Thousand (\$5000.00) DOLLARS,
to them in hand paid by Nellie A. Chesley, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed
and acknowledged,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Nellie A. Chesley
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Town of Tulsa Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: The Westerly fifty feet of lots Five and Six in Block
One Hundred Two, in Tulsa, I. T., according to the Government plat thereof, being
a rectangular piece of ground 50' X 150' described more particularly as follows to-wit:

Beginning at Southwest corner of lot Five block One hundred Two, thence northerly along
lot line 150 feet to northwest corner of lot Six, thence easterly along lot line fifty feet, thence
southerly parallel with west line of lots Five and Six 150 feet to south line of lot Five,
thence westerly along lot line Fifty feet to place of beginning

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Nellie A. Chesley
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
And hereby covenant with said Nellie A. Chesley that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, H. A. Thacker husband wife of the said Luella Thacker for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
Nellie A. Chesley all my rights of ^{Custody} ~~dower~~ and homestead in and to the said lands.
