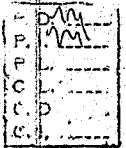

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Emma Drew
and C. C. Drew her husband his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Six Thousand five hundred (\$6500) DOLLARS,
Cash in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said W. B. Campbell
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Beginning 30 feet East of the Northwest corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12,
Township 19, North, Range 12 East; Thence due East 270 feet; thence due South 302 feet; thence
west 270 feet; thence North to point of beginning; Also beginning 32 feet West of the Northeast corner
of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 12-19-12; Thence running due South
202 feet; thence west 135 feet; thence South 100 feet; thence west 135 feet; thence North
302 feet; thence East to point of beginning, all in Section 12, Township 19 North, Range
12 East

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said W. B. Campbell
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
And hereby covenant with said W. B. Campbell, his heirs and assigns that we will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, C. C. Drew, husband wife of the said Emma Drew for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
W. B. Campbell, his heirs and assigns all my rights of ^{Curtsey} ~~dower~~ and homestead in and to the said lands.
