of the sum of Two Hundred and no DOLLARS,
Cash in hand paid Margret Rupp. The receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Margret Rupp
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Gillette and Hall Addition to Tulsa, Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

All of Lots No. Twelve (12) and Thirteen (13) in Block No. Twenty (20) in the Gillette
and Hall Addition to Tulsa, Ind. Ter. according to the survey and plat thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Margret Rupp
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging, except one oil and gas lease to
Sam C. Siskins on his assignor's tract and bind myself
And hereby covenant (with said Margret Rupp that we will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever. persons

And I, Jennie L. Hall and Carrie G. Hocker wives of the said J. M. Hall and J. W. Hocker for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
Margret Rupp all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
