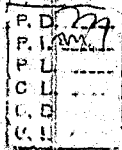

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Chas. Haley and Georgia Haley his wife
 and Paul C. Jones and Emma M. Jones his wife, for and in consideration
 of the sum of One Hundred Fifty Two DOLLARS,
 in hand paid by Mrs. M. M. Bradley, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Mrs. M. M. Bradley
 and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Western
 District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot 10, in Block 5 in Bellview Addition to the Tulsa Ind. Ter.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Mrs. M. M. Bradley
 and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Mrs. M. M. Bradley that we will forever
 warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

and I, Georgia Haley wife of the said Chas. Haley

And I, Emma M. Jones wife of the said Paul C. Jones, do each, for and
 in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
Mrs. M. M. Bradley all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
