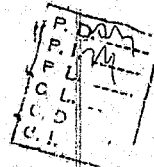

## WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, William Clendenen  
and Anna Clendenen his wife, for and in consideration  
of the sum of Fifteen hundred & fifty DOLLARS,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said J. S. Ingle  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot 1 block 9 in Lindsey second addition to Tulsa as shown by the official survey.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said J. S. Ingle  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant s. with said Anna Clendenen that she will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, William Clendenen husband wife of the said Anna Clendenen for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said  
J. S. Ingle all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
