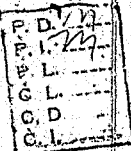

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Frank M. Wooden
and Stella L. Wooden his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Twelve Hundred Fifty & 00/100 DOLLARS,
in hand paid by John E. Mills, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said John E. Mills
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot 7 in Blk 2, in Kind and Gillette Addition to the Town of Tulsa

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said John E. Mills
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said John E. Mills that we will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Stella L. Wooden wife of the said Frank M. Wooden for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
John E. Mills all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
