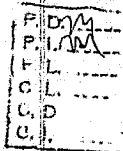

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Lila D. Lindsey
and L. W. Lindsey her husband ~~his~~ wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of One DOLLARS,
In hand paid by Laura E. Mitchell, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Laura E. Mitchell
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Oreek Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots four (4) Five (5) and Six (6) in Block one. Lindsey first addition to Tulsa,
according to plat on record made by J. Gus Patton

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Laura E. Mitchell
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
And hereby covenant with said Laura E. Mitchell that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, L. W. Lindsey husband wife of the said Lila D. Lindsey for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
Laura E. Mitchell ^{Courtesy} all my rights of ~~dower~~ and homestead in and to the said lands.
