do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said International Land Company, its successors
and unto heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the state in the - of Creek Nation, Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The south half of the north west quarter of section twenty one township seventeen (17) north Range thirteen (13) east of the
Sulphur Base and Meridian of the Indian Territory and according to the Government survey thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said International Land Company, its successors
and unto heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant & with said International Land Company that will lawfully for all manneres that I will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.
