WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, G. W. Patrick
and Nancy Patrick his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of One thousand DOLLARS,
to us paid by I. W. Marks, of Units, Ind. Ter.

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said I. W. Marks
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands, lying in the Securing Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 22, Township 19, Range 23; and the S 1/2 of SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 and NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of NW 1/4;
and NE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of NE 1/4, and SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of NW 1/4, and E 1/2 of SW 1/4 of NW 1/4, and SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of NW 1/4, and NW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of NW 1/4
of Section 29, Township 22, Range 13, containing 100 acres, more or less, according to the Government survey thereof, being their
undivided life estate in succession, in the above described lands.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said I. W. Marks
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereto belonging.

And we hereby covenant with the said I. W. Marks that we will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all lawful claims whatever.

And I, Nancy Patrick wife of the said G. W. Patrick for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said I. W. Marks
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
